

INFORMATION FOR PATIENTS UNDERGOING IMPLANT PROCEDURES

You have been scheduled for an implant procedure. Prior to your appointment we want to inform you about what to expect afterwards.

1. At the completion of the procedure we will review all of the post-treatment instructions. These are written down and will be given to you at that time.
2. The instruction sheet also contains diet instructions. You may wish to be on a softer diet following the procedure. We have food recommendations listed for you.
3. If you have the type of case where you must go without teeth for ten to fourteen days, you need to make provisions for a semi-liquid type of diet. You may wish to try several nutritional supplements such as *Ensure* to determine which products have the taste that you prefer. We recommend that you try several products prior to the procedure so that you will have the ability to make these preparations in advance.
4. Please make provisions to apply an ice pack following the procedure. We recommend that you keep ice on and off every five to ten minutes throughout the day. This will help minimize any post-treatment swelling and discomfort.
5. Please obtain your post-treatment medications in advance. This will give you the opportunity to begin taking the medications prior to the procedure. This helps reduce post-treatment pain and swelling. Please call the office if you have any questions about this recommendation.

We realize that most people are a bit anxious prior to any procedure. If you like we can prescribe medication to help you relax. If you desire such medication, you will need to let us know and will need to arrange to have someone drive you to the office and drive you home.
